Position Title:

Temporary Part-time Bilingual Therapist
(Max 29hrs a week, CSAT grant ends in September.
Possibility of FTE depending if grant is refunded)

Basic Function:

To provide family/individual drug and alcohol treatment services to reentry youth and their families in the Youth Transitional Intervention Program (YTIP) outpatient drug & alcohol treatment program and aftercare program.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Provide **individual and family therapy** to families and reentry youth from YTIP in office, client's home or in the natural community using the BSFT model and A-CRA/ACC models, both evidence based models.
- Provide **clinical intake** assessments to youth and families using the Global Appraisal Individual Needs(GAIN) assessment
- Collect GAIN assessments at the 3, 6, and 12 month periods for each client.
- Carry a caseload of 8 clients
- Provide direct service while youth is incarcerated and upon release
- Obtain certification of A-CRA/ACC model and achieve On site GAIN Interviewer certification
- Assist in the facilitation and coordination of monthly peer events (i.e. sober fun activities, running/handball club, college tours etc.)
- Assist with outreach and recruitment within the Probation Department and community
- Collaborate with Probation Officers, Therapist and Unit staff within the Probation Department in youth's transition into the community
- Attend staff & training meetings and **clinical supervision**
- Document all interactions with clients including progress notes, treatment plans, psychosocial assessments and discharge summaries. This includes audio recording sessions for fidelity purposes
- Provide referrals and linkages to youth participants and families
- Abide by the professional code of ethics, including professional confidentiality guidelines by only sharing client information within the organization when it meets the need of the client.

Qualifications:

- **Master degree** from an accredited university in counseling or Social Work.
- **Bilingual English/Spanish a must.**
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Must have knowledge of alcohol & drugs and substance abuse treatment. Knowledge of HIV/AIDS and Hepatitis prevention is a plus
- Experience in working with reentry youth
- Knowledge of juvenile court system
- Computer skills including word processing experience.

Other Information About this Job:

- Must be willing to work two evenings per week and travel is required.
- Willing to work with adolescents ages 11-18 and their families. The majority of our families are low-income, Spanish-speaking youth and families.
- Must have excellent organizational skills and willing to be assertive.
- Looking for someone who can work well independently with effective decision-making ability.
- Will receive 4-day training on A-CRA/ACC by Chestnut Health System in Normal, Illinois.
- Will receive in-house training to become an On-Site Interviewer for the GAIN clinical assessment
- This is a grant funded program from the Center of Substance Abuse and Treatment in the Department of Health and Human Services.
- May provide assistance with other Orange County Bar Foundation programs as needed and other duties as assigned.
